STABLE TOUR



WHAT IS IT? The Stable Tour is a self-guided tour of seven area properties in Metamora.

WHY? It is a chance for people to drive through the beautiful Metamora Hunt Country and see some of the stables and horses – up close and personal. Seven different properties are open for participants to walk through, ask the owners questions and see what makes this area such a unique destination.

WHAT DOES IT COST? The cost is \$25.00 per adult; \$5.00 for kids under 12 years of age.

The money is used to maintain the bridle paths in Metamora Hunt Country

WHEN IS IT? Sunday August 9th from 12noon to 4:00pm

HOW DOES IT WORK? Show up at the **Hunt Kennels 5614 Barber Road, Metamora – Between 11am – 2:30pm** At the Kennels, you will be given a map with the locations of the seven properties that are featured on this year's tour. You will follow the map to visit each of the farms. Volunteers will be at each farm to direct you on where to park and to answer any questions.

HOW LONG

DOES IT TAKE? Approximately two to three hours.

WHERE CAN I BUY TICKETS?

You can buy tickets in advance either at the White Horse or by calling Hunt Master Joe Maday (810.678.8384) – or buy them on the day of the event at the Kennels.

WHAT SHOULD I WEAR?

Dress for comfort and the weather.
All State of MI Covid-19 mandates will be in effect. (masks, social distancing, etc.)

WHAT IF IT RAINS?

The tour is held rain or shine – so dress appropriately.

HOW ARE THE ROADS?

The roads are gravel so watch out for deer and other woodland critters. Give horses and riders the right of way – stop or pass them very slowly.
